Sec. 12-20 Conditions constituting nuisances, specifically.

If any person in this city shall throw, place or deposit, or shall cause to be thrown, placed or deposited, in any street, alley, square, sidewalk, gutter, creek, branch or lot, or in any other place or premises, the carcass of any dead animal or any dead fowl, any putrid or unsound meat of any kind; any fish, hides, skins, melon rinds, vegetables or bones; any offal, dung, or filth of any kind; or any slop, dishwater, waste water, or any unsound or offensive matter of any kind or any matter liable to become offensive; or shall permit any such matter to remain on or about any premises owned by, or controlled by him as agent, tenant or otherwise; or shall permit the same to remain in or upon the street, alley or sidewalk adjoining any premises owned by him or controlled by him as agent, tenant or otherwise, he shall be deemed guilty of creating or maintaining a nuisance and, on conviction thereof, shall be punished as provided in section 1-5 of this Code.

Sec. 1-5 General Provisions

(a.) General penalty for fire, safety, zoning, public health, and sanitation code violations.

Whenever in the City Code or in any ordinance of the city an act in connection with fire safety, zoning, public health, and sanitation (including refuse and wastewater) is prohibited or made or declared to be unlawful or whenever in such code or ordinance the doing of such an act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, the violation of any such provision of this Code or any such ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); provided, however, that no penalty shall be greater or less than the penalty provided for a same or similar offense under the laws of the state. Each day or fractional part thereof any violation of this Code or of any ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.
